Belgium has been one of the first countries to implement the Bologna Accords of 1999. As a result all Belgian universities or universities of applied sciences award their students with the internationally recognized diploma “**Bachelor of Science**” (B.Sc.) or “**Bachelor of Arts**” (B.A.) after three years of study.

For those who would like to start working these academic diplomas may be a sufficient prove of qualification on the job market, whereas it entitles students seeking an even higher level of education to directly access related Master programs practically all over the world.

Examples of the in total over 300 available Bachelor programs in Belgium:

- **International Management** (180 ECTS, 3 years)
- **English literature** (180 ECTS, 3 years)
- **Translation - multiple languages** (180 ECTS, 3 years)
- **Psychology** (180 ECTS, 3 years)
- **Engineering** (180 ECTS, 3 years)

Studying in Belgium



Institutions of higher education (hence, **universities** and **universities of applied sciences**) can be found practically in every bigger Belgian city. The most interesting ones are certainly the universities with sometimes over a couple of centuries tradition such as Ghent, Liege, Leuven as well as the Belgian and European capital Brussels.

These universities welcome and host every year an important number of international students and offer their programs therefore in Dutch, French or English. For some of these programs a proof of language proficiency (such as the **DEL/DALF** for French or the **TOEFL** for English) may be required.

DEL/DALF

The DELF/DALF is issued by the French minister of education and can be obtained in four steps A1, A2, A3 and A4. It serves as a proof of language proficiency in the French speaking universities of Brussels, Louvain La Neuve and Liège and Mons.

Test of English as a foreign language (TOEFL)

The TOEFL is the mostly accomplished and the most widely accepted certificate of English language proficiency. Being in possession of the TOEFL will entitle you to enroll into all English study programs.

Application process

The application process for non-EU students willing to study at Belgian universities starts in December and may last until April. During this process, entry exams, motivation letters or even interviews may be executed.

Housing

Accommodations exist in all forms and for all available budgets. The range may go from a host family to a private apartment.
