If you would like to learn Russian in Russia you have the choice between the Russian capital Moscow or the former tsars residence city Saint Petersburg.

No matter which destination you will opt for, you can either attend a standard (20h/week) or an intensive (25h/week) group course. Should you prefer learning individually we also organize 15-40h/week one-to-one language trainings with a private teacher.
